DEED OF GIFT

Southern California Yachting Association
Multihull Perpetual
US SAILING Area J Champion

The above named perpetual trophy is the property the Southern California Yachting Association (SCYA). The trophy was created by funds from the King Harbor Yacht Club Multihull Fleet and SCYA as an incentive to encourage multihull sailing in Southern California and participation in the US SAILING Multihull Championship for the Alter Cup. This trophy will be preserved, controlled, and awarded under the following conditions.

1. The trophy is a smoke blue Lexon catamaran mounted on a black acrylic cube base. It shall be known as the Southern California Yachting Association Multihull Perpetual US SAILING Area J Champion, as designated by an engraving with that title on the trophy.
2. The trophy is a property of SCYA and it shall be insured, maintained, and controlled by that organization.
3. The trophy shall be awarded to the winning team of the annual US SAILING Area J Multihull Championship at the conclusion of the regatta. This regatta will be the Area J elimination for the US SAILING Multihull Championship for the Alter Cup. The trophy may be re-awarded at subsequent yachting events upon approval of the SCYA Trophy Chairman.
4. The US SAILING Area J Championship competitor eligibility and regatta format will be dictated by the US SAILING Notice of Race and Conditions for the Multihull Championship for the Alter Cup.
5. The winner of this trophy may retain possession of it after the event, providing it is displayed in a secured trophy case at the skipper's member club. Otherwise, it shall be displayed in the secure trophy case at King Harbor Yacht Club. The display location will be determined by the SCYA Trophy Chairman.

6. The trophy shall be returned to the US SAILING Area J Multihull Championship Representative no later than thirty (30) days prior to the annual Area J Multihull Championship event.

7. The SCYA trophy chairman shall maintain records showing possession and condition of the trophy. SCYA shall be responsible for the plaques with inscriptions of the winners to be placed on the trophy.

8. The trophy shall not carry any commercial connotations or advertising or be used in any manner where such use may suggest endorsement of any product or service.

9. The SCYA Board of Directors may change any of the terms of this Deed of Gift where they deem such change beneficial to the promotion of sailing or the improvement of the competition for the trophy. This may include retiring or re-deeding this trophy.

10. The trophy shall remain the property of the Southern California Yachting Association or its successor. If they cease to exist then the trophy shall first be offered to King Harbor Yacht Club and if not accepted then be given to such other organization as may best promote multihull sailing.
