

SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA YACHTING ASSOCIATION
DEED OF GIFT
CLUB OF THE YEAR AWARD

The Club of the Year Award shall be awarded annually by SCYA in recognition of the Senior, Regular and Associate club's outstanding display of participation within the activities of Southern California Yachting Association. The award is given for the highest number of points in each of the categories for the three membership levels.

The following prerequisites shall govern this deed:

The above named perpetual trophy to be awarded to the SENIOR Member, a silver wine cooler mounted to a wood base with plaques attached to the wood base for club identification and year; similarly to the REGULAR Member, a silver punch bowl with 6 silver cups mounted around the bowl on a wood base; and again similarly to the ASSOCIATE Member, a silver punch bowl mounted to a wood base also with plaques attached to the wood base for club identification and year.

1. This award shall be presented to the Senior, Regular and Associate levels of membership only once in any calendar year.
2. These awards shall consist of perpetual trophies. These trophies are directed into the charge of the SCYA which shall be responsible for providing suitable take home trophies. Said take home trophies shall show the name of the winner, the year awarded and the full name of each of the perpetual trophies.
3. The time, date and place for the trophy presentation shall be prescribed by the Board of Directors of SCYA, traditionally at the January Change of Watch Ceremonies. However, the Commodore of SCYA, or his designee, may deem it appropriate to make a presentation at an opening day ceremony or other function of the winner's club.
4. **Calculations** for this award begin on **January 1** of each year and end on **November 30**. The eleven month period will be used to acrew the points for each of the three membership levels.
5. The yacht club will at all times provide insurance coverage of the perpetual trophy which provides total and complete coverage for the replacement of said trophy in the case of loss due to theft, fire or damage of any kind. This coverage must be maintained at all times the perpetual trophy is in the club's possession.
6. The club officer from the club shall sign a "Receipt Agreement," provided by the SCYA trophy chairman, by which it shall engage and bind the club to hold the perpetual trophy subject to and within the terms and conditions of this deed.
7. Full authority over the Deed of Gift is vested in the Board of Directors of SCYA, and all actions concerning this deed including ammendments shall be voted on under the provisions set forth in the organization's Bylaws.
