DEED OF GIFT

The Newport Ocean Sailing Association, in memory of James M. (Jim) Webster, presents to the Southern California Yachting Association a Perpetual Trophy, to be known as the JIM WEBSTER PERPETUAL TROPHY, to be awarded in recognition of an outstanding contribution to Yachting.

The Commodore of the Southern California Yachting Association, or such committee as he may appoint, shall select the person to receive the award, which shall be made annually, if there is a worthy recipient, but, in the absence thereof, need not be made each year. The individual so selected need not be actively engaged in sailing events, nor the winner of a number of races, nor a yacht owner, need not be nor have been a flag officer of a Yacht Club, but may be, among others, a Race Committeeman, a member of the press, someone who has displayed exceptional sportsmanship, or someone not directly associated with Yachting, if such person qualifies as having made an outstanding contribution to Yachting.

At such time as an award is made, as herein provided, the recipient's name and the year of the award shall be engraved upon the trophy and the recipient shall be entitled to the possession of the trophy, or to have same deposited in his Yacht Club during the term of the award.

Should the Southern California Yachting Association or the Newport Ocean Sailing Association cease to exist, the rights conveyed hereunder shall vest in their respective successor organizations.

The donor reserves the right to make such amendments as are necessary to carry out the wishes and spirit of the donor.
